

2018/2019 lion hunts

We had 4 hunters and killed 4 cats. The last cat jumped over a cliff and we could not retrieve him.

2019 spring bear

We had 2 bear hunters and killed 2 large boar bears

Fall cast and blast

The first hunt we had 3 hunters. Two hunters cancelled out. The last hunter killed 2 large boars and almost shot some wolves

The second hunt we had a lady hunter. She shot a large boar.

Sheep hunt

We had 1 sheep hunter and he shot a 155 ram 2 hours into his hunt. We spent a few days scouting prior to his hunt.

Archery elk

The first week we had 1 hunter. He was from Florida and left early because there was a hurricane happening at home.

The second week had 2 hunters. They had some close calls with bulls and shot a doe for meat.

The third week had 2 hunters. They shot a 330 bull.

The last week had 3 hunters. They wounded a bull, shot a 6-point bull, shot a doe for meat and had some other close calls.

We had two drop campers and they shot a 5-point bull.

Other than the first hunter, I think all archery hunters drew their bows back or were into elk most every day. We saw some good bulls on these hunts.

Wilderness bugle hunts

We had 15 hunters on the first 4 hunts and we killed 10 bulls and 2 bucks. It seems they were evenly spread out on which hunts they came from. We also had some missed bulls and other close calls.

Front range deer hunts

We had 5 deer hunters Oct. 10-14 and killed 5 bucks and missed one or two other bucks

We had 2 whitetail hunters out of the lodge and killed a small 3pt (8pt eastern count) and missed another buck

Front range combination hunts

We had 5 hunters on the opening hunt and killed 2 bulls and 3 bucks. We also missed some bulls and passed up some smaller bulls. We had 3 drop campers and they did not kill anything.

The second hunt we had 5 hunters and killed 4 bulls and missed 2 bulls. We had 2 drop campers and they did not kill anything.

The third hunt we had 4 hunters and killed 2 bulls, passed up several bulls and missed a bull. One of the hunters had a goat tag and took a nice billy.

Wilderness late season elk/deer in November

The first week of November we had 6 hunters and killed 6 bucks and a bull.

The second week we had 8 hunters and killed 2 bulls and 8 bucks.

The last week we had 10 hunters and killed 9 bucks.

Overall, the season went well. Many hunters worked hard to get in shape and a few showed up and were overwhelmed at the size and steepness of our country. After 25 years of owning the business, I guess it does not surprise me that we still get folks who underestimate the ruggedness of central Idaho. We only had one person show up with a long-range scope that did not have a cover on the windage turret. I think everyone had fun. If they didn't, they missed a damn good chance because the guides and I had a great time. I drew a moose tag and harvested a moose for myself. This completed my Idaho slam for my 4 trophy species. As more folks move to Idaho, the odds of drawing those coveted tags are getting tougher but you can not draw if you do not apply. Good luck and let us know if we can help.
